LA CITÉ FRUGÈS – LE CORBUSIER INSCRIBED IN THE UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE LIST !

Did you know that Pessac is host to an exceptional site standing as testimony to Modern French architecture?

Built between 1924 and 1926 by urban architect Le Corbusier at the request of industrialist and artist Henry Frugès, the "cité-jardin" (garden city) represents a remarkable and innovative project, born of the collaboration between the two men and the architect's inspiration. It marked Le Corbusier's first big scale realisation which made of him a true precursor in terms of comfort and aesthetics for low-cost housing.

The cultural importance of the Quartiers Modernes Frugès was officially recognised when it was inscribed in the Unesco World Heritage Cultural index last year

Feel free to wonder around the Cité to discover fifty housing units built following six different designs: zigzag, quinconce, jumelle, gratte-ciel, arcade, isolée, and make sure to visit the show house!

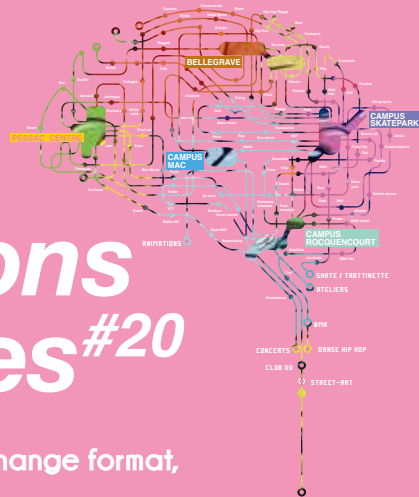

For its 20th edition, the urban vibrations change format, they settle on the campus !



The festival, which presents the urban culture in all its forms, will take its districts from October 31st to November 5th on the university campus of Pessac, the Bellegrave and Pessac Centers :

- at the level of the gymnasium of Rocquencourt, the skateboard, the BMX or the child's scooter will be put at the honor, through contest and animations,
- activities like the slackline, the pump track or the parkours, will be proposed to the visitors during all the festival at the COSEC and its outsides,
- the Bellegrave room remains the unbeatable place of the evenings of the Urban Vibrations: concerts, Roller Derby and Battle of dance hip hop,

- the center of Pessac, as for him, will propose exhibitions of the street art, realization of fresco and workshops.

Animations and workshops will be organized during the 6 days of festival. The visitors will be able to discover free activities like the slackline, the hoverboard, football freestyle or the beatboxing.

For the students, specific rates are planned for animations like for the key periods of the Urban Vibrations.
